## LOCATION

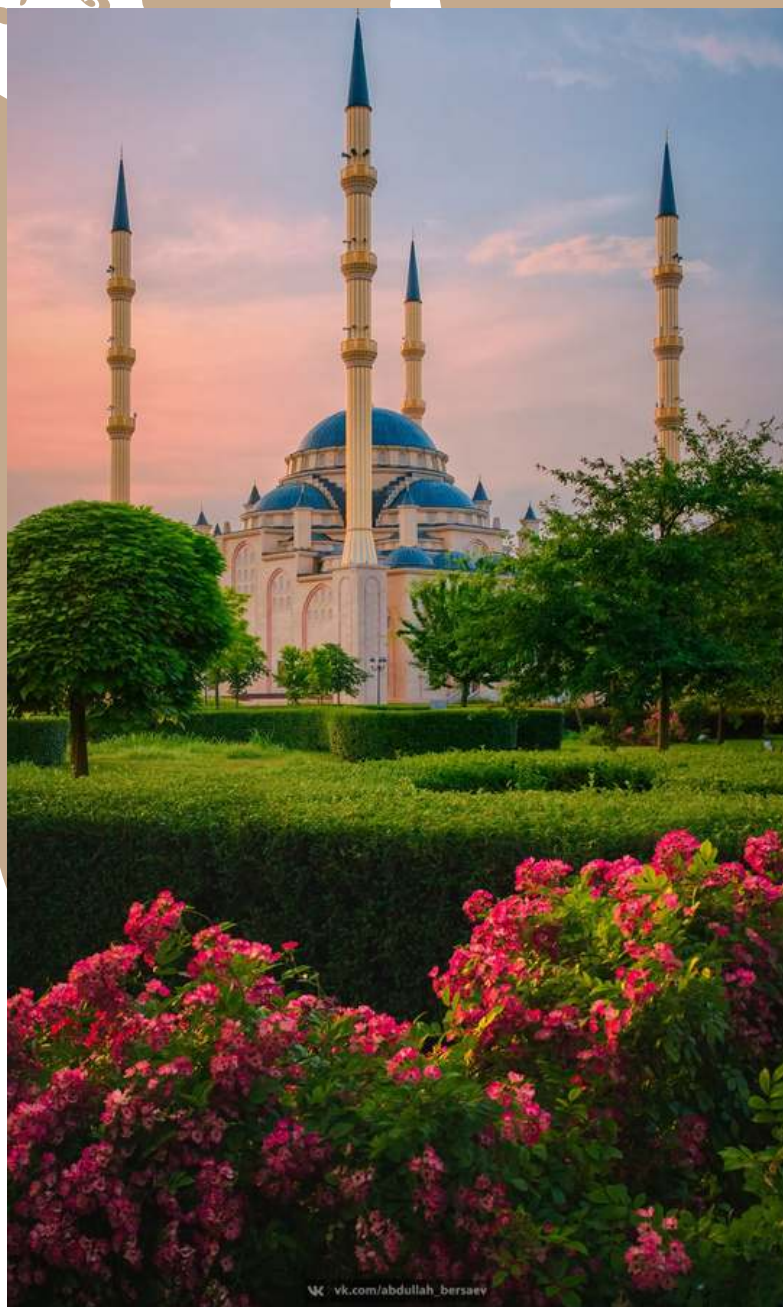
The Chechen Republic is situated in the heart of the North Caucasus, bridging the majestic Greater Caucasus Mountains in the south with the vast Chechen Plain and the Terek–Kuma Lowland in the north. Its unique position gives the region a remarkable mix of mountain, foothill, and steppe landscapes. The capital city, Grozny, is located along the Sunzha River and serves as a major educational, cultural, and economic hub. From Grozny, students can easily travel to other cities in the North Caucasus and southern Russia.



## GROZNY

Grozny is a Caucasian phoenix city, reborn from the ashes.

It is the capital of the Chechen Republic—a city with a dramatic history that has endured wars, deportations, and large-scale destruction. In the 1990s, Grozny was almost completely destroyed. Today, it is a modern, rapidly developing city, known for its new buildings and contemporary architecture. Grozny is safe for tourists, and the Chechen people are among the most hospitable in Russia.



At the end of the 1990s, Grozny was the largest industrial, cultural, and scientific center of the North Caucasus. In the 1990s the city was destroyed and its infrastructure almost completely. In 2006, an active phase of reconstruction began. Grozny turned into a vast construction site, and between 2007 and 2009 the city was rebuilt at a pace that under normal conditions would have taken decades. Today, Grozny has moved beyond recovery challenges and is focused on intensive development, with the city center acquiring a modern and dynamic appearance.

### THE HEART OF CHECHNYA MOSQUE

The Heart of Chechnya Mosque is the main mosque of Grozny and one of the largest mosques in Europe. It is a symbol of the city's revival, known for its impressive Ottoman-style architecture, elegant minarets, and beautiful interior decoration. The mosque is located in the city center and serves as an important spiritual, cultural, and architectural landmark of the Chechen Republic.



Dear students,

While exploring the Chechen Republic, you will discover one of the most unique symbols of our history – the ancient Chechen watchtowers. These stone towers were built between the 12th and 17th centuries and served as both defensive structures and symbols of strength, honor, and unity of the Chechen people. These towers were traditionally constructed in mountainous areas, especially in the southern regions of Chechnya, where families and clans (teips) built them to protect their communities. The architecture of the towers is remarkable: tall, narrow, and made entirely of stone, often rising 20–25 meters high. Despite centuries of time, many of them still stand strong today.

Visiting these towers gives you the opportunity not only to enjoy breathtaking mountain landscapes but also to touch centuries-old history and understand the resilience and spirit of the Chechen people.

If you travel to the mountains, you may see preserved towers in places such as Itum-Kale, Sharoy, and other highland districts.



Here you can see the map of Chechnya with the regions split up by the traditional felt carpets (Istang) which are from these region. The Chechen carpet is not just a decorative item; it is a vivid expression of Chechen culture, history, and craftsmanship. Traditionally handmade, these carpets are woven with great care and skill, often by women in Chechen households, and have been an essential part of domestic life for centuries.



The Ushkaloy Towers date back to the 10th–11th centuries. They are believed to have served a border-guard function, and it is assumed that a customs checkpoint may have been located inside. The towers are approximately 12 meters high. Three of the four walls are built from local sandstone, while the fourth wall is formed by a natural rock cliff, and the roof is a stone overhang.

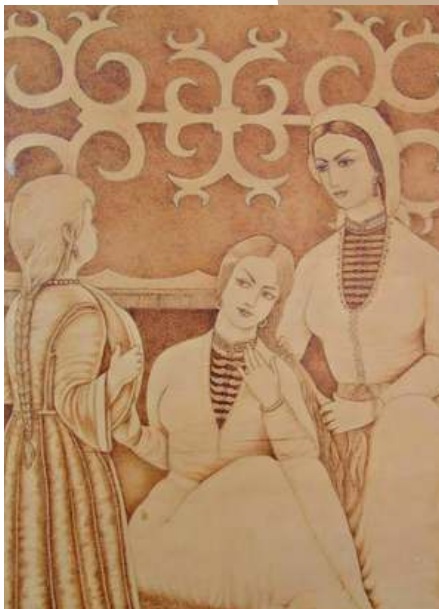
Chechens view children as very holy, just like women. They're the future of us and that's why Chechens were always particularly fond of their kid's upbringing.

Regardless of gender, Chechens always teach their children to respect the elders, to recognise the authority of their parents, to revere Chechen folk costumes ('Adatash) and many other things. All harmful habits are strictly forbidden.

Grandparents also play a big role in the upbringing of the children among Chechens. They're the wisest and are best able to teach the next generation the right things.

Other certain customs among Chechens in the upbringing of their children are: not praising them in front of others or too much in general, it is believed to spoil them.

A very important thing is to kill selfishness. It's obligatory for both genders to immediately stand up when an elder enters the room. It's obligatory to teach them to be modest in everyday life, even with food. Both genders are also taught to help adults in any way they can.



Attitude of Chechen men towards (Chechen) women:

„In general, Chechens are very chaste towards women, the mutual relations of young men and girls bear the character of respect for female modesty. Chechens will never allow themselves not only to offend a girl somehow, but even to touch her with their hand, otherwise universal contempt awaits him"

"Mutual relations between young men and girls are distinguished by full respect for female modesty, which is the dignity of a girl"



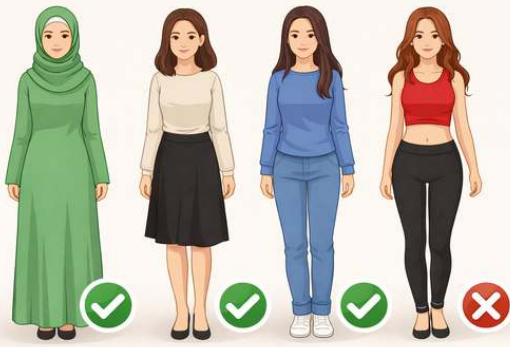
### Some interesting facts about Chechen tribes

Unlike many other nations, the Chechen people never had princes or monarchs. Chechen society was traditionally organized around clans (teips) and councils of elders. Leadership was based on respect, wisdom, and consensus rather than inherited titles. Decisions were made collectively, and authority came from personal qualities and the trust of the community, not from royal lineage.

This unique social structure helped preserve equality among clans and reinforced the importance of family honor, community solidarity, and respect for elders.

Like almost every other nation in the Caucasus, Chechens are also divided into different tribes (Tayp). Tribes played an important role in the socioeconomic life of the Chechens in the middle ages, and continued to be an important cultural part to this day. Tayps often descend from a common ancestor or geographical place.

1. Something interesting about Chechen tayps is that almost all of them had their own god and their own cult with rituals/customs.
2. Each Tayp also had a certain festival associated with their "tribe-god". But there were also other festivals, such as spring festivals or New Year. Festivals were held near a "tsu" (temple).
3. Majority of the Chechen tribes also have their own tower (combat tower, tower complex) and their own mountain.
4. Each tribe had its own cemetery, where only people from that specific tribe were buried.
5. Each tribe also had their own elder council, called Taypan-Kkhel.



### Dress Code for girls

Clothing should be modest and appropriate. Please avoid wearing clothes with open shoulders, exposed stomachs, short skirts, tight leggings, or other revealing outfits.

### Dress Code for men

#### Clothing for Male Students

Male students are not allowed to wear shorts, both on the university campus and outside the university in the city.



### Dormitory Rules

Male and female students are not allowed to visit each other's cottages or dormitory areas on the residence campus.

### Cleanliness and Waste Disposal

Littering on the university campus or outside the university is strictly prohibited. Throwing garbage outside designated trash bins may lead to disciplinary action.



### Dormitory Cleanliness and Waste Management

Students living in the dormitories are required to maintain cleanliness and order in their rooms. Rooms should be kept tidy and hygienic at all times. Garbage must be disposed of regularly and not allowed to accumulate inside the room.



### Alcohol Prohibition

The consumption of any alcoholic beverages is prohibited in the Chechen Republic.



### Respect for Local Residents

Taking photos or videos of local girls and women with phones or other devices is strictly prohibited.

International accreditation is a procedure for assessing the compliance of Russian educational programs with international and European quality standards. It is carried out by accreditation agencies that are members of the European Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (ENQA) and are listed in the European Quality Assurance Register (EQAR).

Following an international expert evaluation, Chechen State University has received international accreditation for the following educational programs: Business Informatics, ICT and Communication Systems, Software Engineering, General Medicine, Dentistry, and Pediatrics. Of particular importance is the fact that Chechen State University is the first and only university in the North Caucasus Federal District (NCFD) to obtain international accreditation in medical specialties.

Students actively participate in a wide range of extracurricular activities, including various sports events, as well as cultural and musical programs.



The university offers comfortable cottage-type dormitories designed to provide a safe and cozy living environment for students. The dormitories are equipped with all necessary amenities, creating a convenient and home-like atmosphere.



Students actively explore the Chechen Republic through frequent educational trips and excursions, allowing them to discover the region's rich culture, history, and natural beauty.



Students regularly participate in academic competitions and Olympiads, where they demonstrate their knowledge, skills, and intellectual potential. Such activities encourage academic excellence, critical thinking, and professional growth.



### Accreditation and Simulation Center

The center is equipped with modern training devices, mannequins, anatomical models, robotic simulators, and advanced virtual simulation systems designed specifically for medical students.





### Study Conditions

- Duration of study: 6–10 months (1–2 semesters).
- Average group size: 8–12 students.
- The program includes both practical and lecture-based classes.
- Maximum study load: 40 academic hours per week.
- Classes are held daily (4–5 hours per day).

At the end of the academic year, students take final exams in Russian language and specialized subjects. Upon successful completion of the program and final examinations, they receive an official Certificate of Chechen State University named after A. A. Kadyrov.

The Preparatory Department for International Students at Chechen State University named after A. A. Kadyrov offers pre-university training programs. These programs last 10 months and include modules in Russian language and specialized subjects relevant to the student's future field of study. Students may also choose a separate intensive Russian language course lasting 6 months.

### Application Deadlines

#### First Intake – 10-month Program

- Application period: May 15 – July 15 (annually)
- Study period: October – July
- Tuition fee: 85,000 RUB

#### Second Intake – 6-month Program

- Application period: September 15 – November 15 (annually)
- Study period: February – July
- Tuition fee: 85,000 RUB



### Required Documents

- A copy of the passport or identification document valid in the Russian Federation
- (passport must be valid for at least 18 months from the date of entry)
  - notarized translation into Russian.
- A copy of the education certificate and/or qualification document
  - notarized translation into Russian.
- Completed application form (sent after registration to [inter.application@chesu.ru](mailto:inter.application@chesu.ru), and also after signing the contract and paying the tuition fee if an invitation for entry into the Russian Federation is required).

### Admission Requirements

International citizens and stateless persons with any level of education—secondary, vocational, or higher—may apply. Applicants must provide a document confirming their educational qualification.

Enrollment in the preparatory course is based on direct contracts with organizations or individuals upon full payment of tuition. Exceptions apply to students admitted through the quota established by the Government of the Russian Federation.

The tuition fee for the 2025–2026 academic year is 85,000 RUB, payable before arrival at the university.

Classes begin on October 1 as soon as groups are formed.

All preparatory department students are provided with dormitory accommodation. The university is responsible for completing migration registration for all preparatory course students.

## HOW TO APPLY 6 STEPS TO ENROLL IN THE PREPARATORY PROGRAMS

### STEP 1. PREPARE YOUR DOCUMENTS

- Make a color scan of your identity document (passport) valid in the Russian Federation (the passport must be valid for at least 18 months on the day of entry into Russia), along with a notarized translation into Russian.
  - Make a color scan of your educational document and/or qualification certificate, accompanied by a notarized translation into Russian.
  - Complete the application form.
  - Wait for an email with a scanned confirmation letter stating that your documents have been received, along with further instructions.

### STEP 2. CONFIRMATION OF YOUR APPLICATION AND SIGNING THE EDUCATION CONTRACT

The university reviews your documents within at least 10 business days.

If your application is approved, an education contract for paid preparatory programs will be sent to the email address you indicated in your application form (your personal email or your agent's email).

- Print the contract and read it carefully.
- If you agree with the terms, sign the contract, scan it in PDF format, and send it to:

### STEP 3. TUITION PAYMENT ACCORDING TO THE CONTRACT

All students undertaking their summer clinical practice in the Chechen Republic are required to obtain a valid medical book (**медицинская книжка**) issued by the Sanitary and Epidemiological Authorities of the Chechen Republic in the following cases:

- if this is your first year of clinical practice; or
- if you do not already possess a valid medical book.

In order to obtain the medical book, students must undergo a mandatory set of:

- medical examinations;
- laboratory investigations;
- specialist consultations.

These procedures are required by the healthcare regulatory authorities to ensure the safety of both students and the patients with whom they will be working.

Students who already possess a medical book from the previous academic year are required to:

1. renew the medical book;
2. repeat all required laboratory tests and medical examinations as instructed by the sanitary authorities.

Students will only be permitted to begin their clinical practice after fulfilling all requirements and obtaining a valid medical book bearing the official stamp:

“Допущен к работе” (“Allowed access to work”).

### Guidelines for Students Completing Clinical Practice in Home Countries

Students who plan to complete their clinical practice in their home countries must ensure that the practice is conducted exclusively in a hospital setting. Small private clinics, outpatient centers, or ambulatory facilities are not acceptable.

The hospital must include at least the following major inpatient departments:

- Internal Medicine (Therapy);
- Surgery.

This requirement is mandatory in order to ensure adequate clinical exposure and comprehensive professional training.

Upon completion of practice, students must provide the following documents:

1. an official confirmation/guarantee letter issued by the hospital;
2. a completed practice diary (to be provided);
3. an official reference letter from the clinical supervisor.

Failure to comply with the above requirements may result in the practice not being officially recognized.

#### Duration of Clinical Practice

The total duration of practice is 4 weeks, including:

- 2 weeks — Internal Medicine (Therapy)
- 2 weeks — Surgery

Please note that the exact dates and departmental assignments may vary from one student group to another.

Students will be provided with official admission cards (referral forms). These documents are of official importance and must not be lost under any circumstances.

#### Required Documents Upon Completion of Practice

At the conclusion of clinical practice, each student must submit:

- a completed practice diary (to be provided);
- an official reference letter from the clinical supervisor.

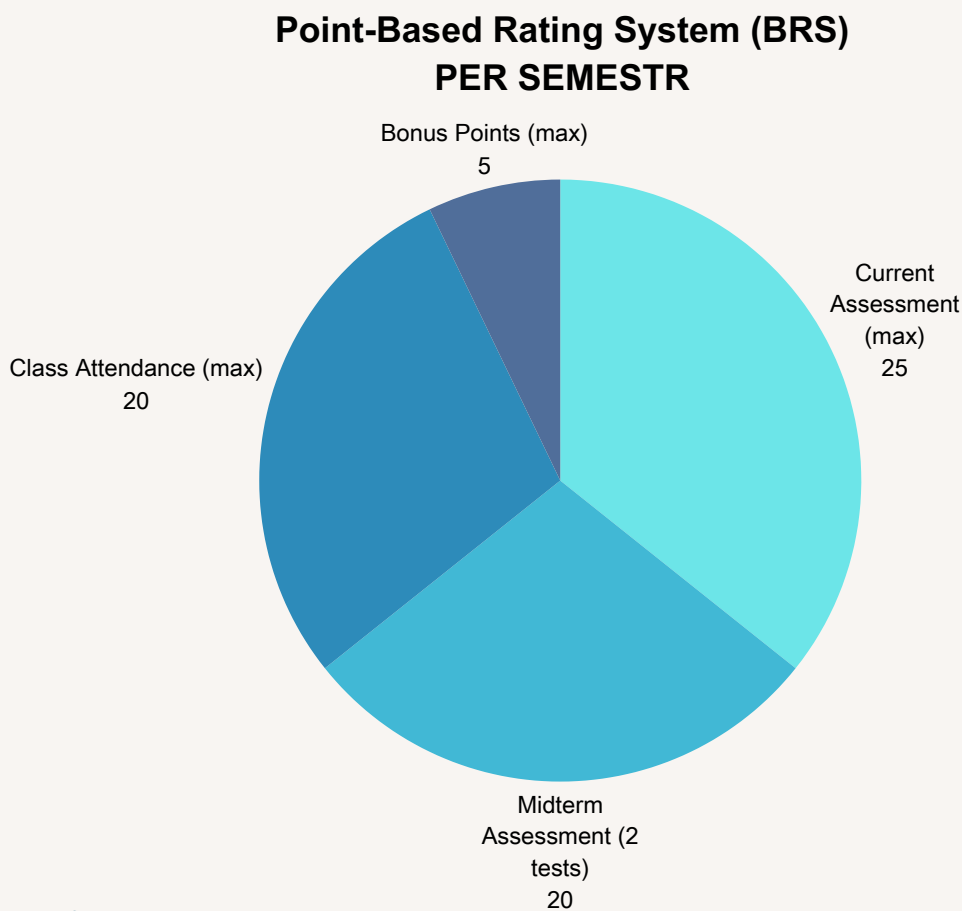
All requirements listed above are mandatory and must be strictly observed.

Student academic performance within the Point-Based Rating System (BRS) is evaluated throughout the semester based on several components. Each component contributes a specific number of points to the final score.

Assessment is carried out through:

- current assessment
- Midterm assessment
- Class attendance
- Bonus and penalty points

The maximum total score per discipline per semester is 70 points.



#### Explanation of Components

- **Current Assessment (25 points):** Includes quizzes, assignments, practical work, and other ongoing evaluations during the semester.
- **Midterm Assessment (20 points):** Consists of two intermediate tests assessing students' progress and understanding of the material.
- **Class Attendance (20 points):** Points are awarded for regular attendance and active participation in classes.
- **Bonus / Penalty Points (±5 points):** Bonus points may be awarded for exceptional performance or academic initiative, while penalty points may be deducted for violations of academic discipline or poor attendance.

Continuous monitoring of academic progress directly influences the final semester grade. This regulation establishes a transparent framework for converting a student's average academic mark into standardized rating points.

## GRADING AND ADMISSION POLICY



Please note the following grading and admission policy:



### AUTOMATIC PASS

Students who earn 51 points or higher are eligible for an automatic pass (meaning that during the final class they simply sign their record book without any additional assessment).

For disciplines that include a final examination – such as Biology and Chemistry (1st year); Normal Physiology and Biochemistry (2nd year); Propaedeutics of Internal Diseases, General Surgery, Pharmacology, and Pathological Physiology (3rd year) – the minimum score required for an automatic pass is **40 points or higher.**



### ADMISSION TO THE FINAL CREDIT ASSESSMENT

Admission to the final credit assessment (meaning that during the last class the instructor may conduct an oral assessment or additional questioning to allow the student to earn missing points) is granted under the following conditions:



**40 POINTS OR HIGHER**  
for regular disciplines

and



**31 POINTS OR HIGHER**  
for examination-based  
disciplines



**If a student has:**

- fewer than 40 points in a regular discipline, or
- fewer than 31 points in an examination-based discipline,

**Q1. I would like to apply to Chechen State University (ChSU), but not to the Faculty of International Education. Will instruction at other faculties be conducted in English?**

A: In this case, you will need to complete the admission process to the Preparatory Faculty and study Russian for 9 months. Only after that will you be eligible to enroll in a Russian-taught degree program.

**Q2. Is the language of instruction at the Faculty of International Education English?**

A: The language of instruction is English, so you do not need to enroll in the Preparatory Faculty or study Russian before starting your degree.

**Q3. Is Russian taught as a foreign language at the Faculty of International Education?**

A: You will study Russian as a foreign language for 3 years as part of the program.

**Q4. Do universities provide textbooks and manuals?**

A: The university library provides all required textbooks and study materials free of charge. Students have full access to academic resources throughout their studies.

**Q5. Can a foreign student apply for a place in the dormitory?**

A: Modern on-campus dormitories and cottage-style residences are available for international students. The accommodation is conveniently located within a 20-minute walking distance from the Faculty of International Education.

**Q6: Is there Indian or vegetarian food in the campus cafeteria?**

A: No, there is no Indian food in the cafeteria. Most of the dishes contain meat. Vegetarian dishes are prepared only occasionally.

**Q7: What will happen if I have more than three absences during the semester?**

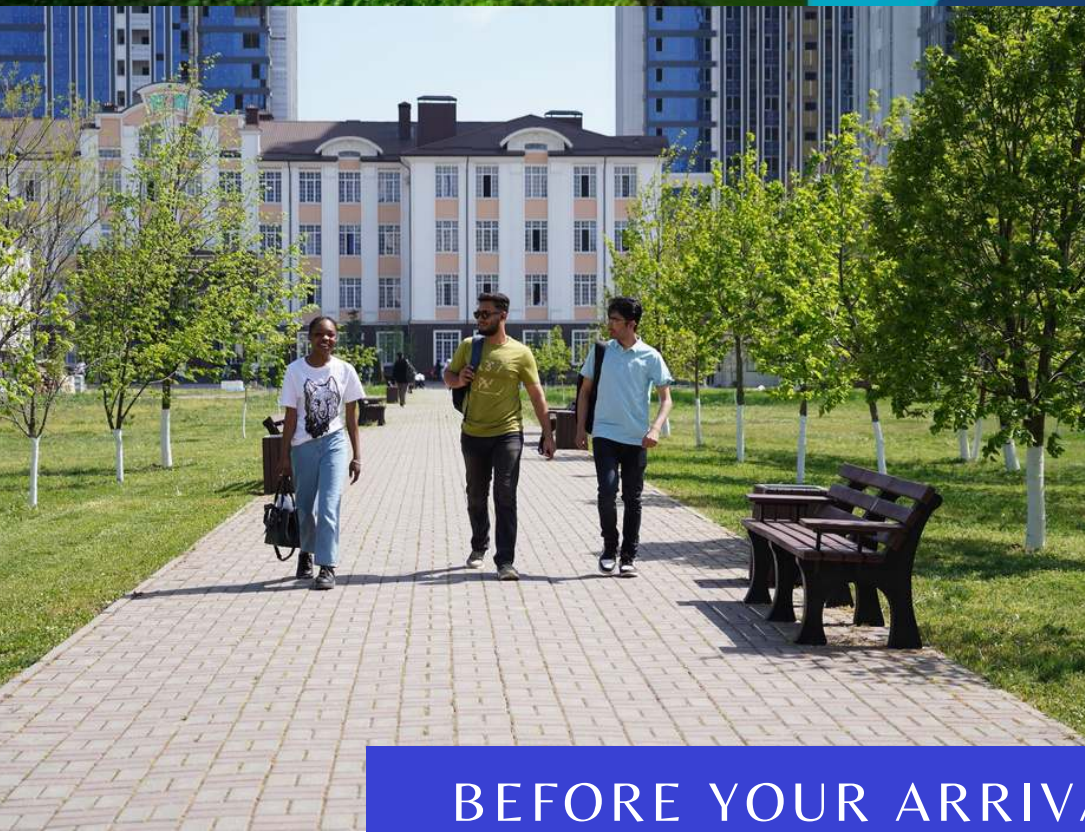
A: If you receive three N marks, your attendance percentage will drop from 100% to 70%. In this case, you will not receive attendance points toward your final grade.

**Q8: What happens if I do not earn enough points to pass the course or exam by the end of the exam week? Do I have an opportunity to retake it?**

A: Yes, you may have an opportunity to retake the course. If you have a valid reason for missing classes, you can retake the discipline, but you must provide official proof. However, if you do not have a valid reason, you will need to pay a fee of 25,000 rubles for one discipline.

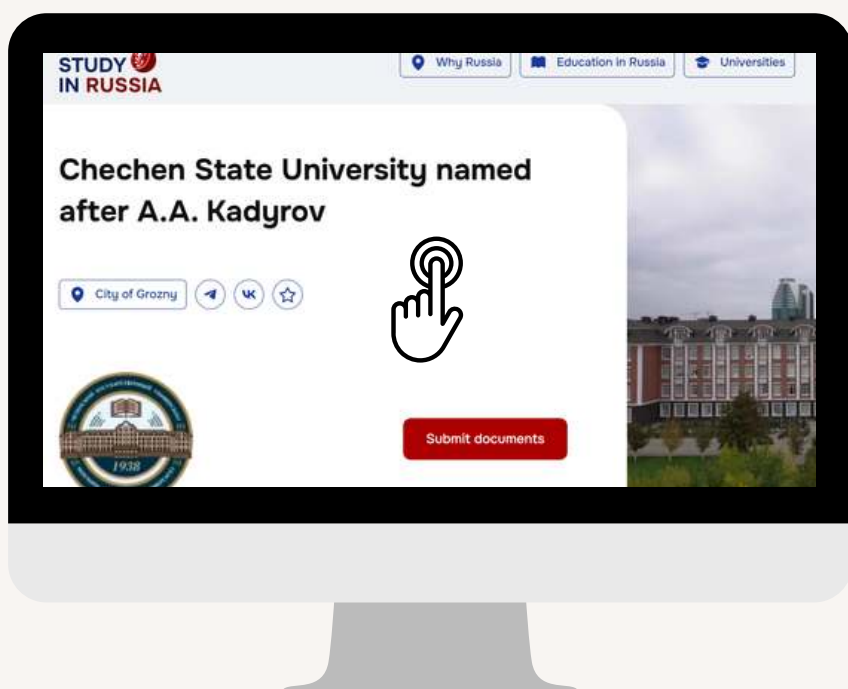

## 2.7 MEDICAL EDUCATION IN RUSSIA

**Medical education in Russia** is renowned for its high quality, driven by the professionalism of its faculty, a wide range of academic programs—including those taught in English and French—and affordable tuition fees supported by partial government funding. In addition, studying at Russian medical universities offers international students excellent opportunities for professional development and career advancement in the field of medicine.

### How Is Medical Education Structured in Russia?

Medical education in Russia is characterized by a complex and multi-level system.

**First Level: Specialist Degree (5–6 years of study)**

The starting point of medical education in Russia is enrollment in Specialist Degree programs.

To apply, an applicant must provide a certificate of complete secondary education with academic transcripts. It is important that the applicant studied biology, chemistry, and physics at school.

The duration of study for Specialist Degree programs is as follows:

- General Medicine – 6 years
- Dentistry – 5 years
- Pharmacy – 5 years
- Veterinary Medicine – 5 years



**Second Level: Residency (2–5 years of study)**

To obtain a narrow medical specialization—such as surgeon, cardiologist, gastroenterologist (or more than 100 other specialties)—and to be able to practice independently without supervision from senior colleagues, graduates must complete residency training.

The duration of residency ranges from 2 to 5 years, depending on the chosen specialty and the legal requirements of the country, which determine the mandatory length of training for professional recognition.

**Third Level: Postgraduate Studies (PhD) (3 years of study)**

If a student plans to focus on scientific research rather than clinical practice, they may consider enrolling in postgraduate (PhD) studies.

To be admitted to a PhD program, an applicant must hold a higher medical education diploma and a completed residency diploma.



## 2.7 MEDICAL EDUCATION IN RUSSIA

**Advantages of Medical Education in Russia**

- **High Quality of Education:** Russia is recognized as one of the leaders in higher medical education due to its strong academic traditions and long-standing expertise in this field.
- **Affordable Tuition Fees:** Studying at Russian medical universities is significantly more affordable (on average USD 2,500–3,500 per academic year) compared to similar programs in the United States and Europe (approximately USD 50,000 per academic year).
- **Strong Fundamental Training:** Special emphasis is placed on core basic disciplines such as anatomy, histology, biochemistry, as well as clinical subjects including surgery and internal medicine, which is a key feature of Russian medical education.
- **Advanced Technical Facilities:** Russian medical universities receive substantial government funding and are equipped with modern teaching technologies, laboratories, and medical equipment, which are regularly upgraded.
- **Preparatory Programs for International Students:** Many medical universities offer preparatory (foundation) programs for international applicants, designed to prepare students for medical studies in the Russian language. The duration of such programs is one academic year.

## 2.9 LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

In the Chechen Republic, there are two official languages:

**Russian & Chechen**

The **Faculty of International Education** is the only faculty with full instruction in **English**.

**No official language certificates are required!**



**Admission to the Faculty of International Education** is open to applicants without prior knowledge of the Russian language. The university provides comprehensive Russian language training as part of the academic program, with a duration of three years, ensuring that students gradually develop the necessary language skills for both academic and everyday communication.

The main instruction is conducted in English, allowing international students to comfortably begin their studies from the first year. At the same time, the integrated approach to language learning enables students to become proficient in Russian, which enhances their academic experience and helps them better adapt to life in the Russian Federation.



### Preparatory Faculty

Applicants who wish to enroll in Russian-language academic programs at the university are required to submit their documents in advance and accept the official offer of admission.

After completing the admission process, students begin a nine-month intensive Russian language course designed to develop the linguistic and academic skills necessary for successful study in Russian. The program focuses on all key aspects of language learning, including speaking, listening, reading, and writing, as well as subject-specific terminology.

Detailed information regarding the application process and submission of documents to the Preparatory Faculty can be found in (handbook 1.6)

Upon successful completion of the preparatory program, students are eligible to continue their studies in their chosen Russian-language degree program if they have Russian language certificate.



## 2.10 VISA &amp; ENTRY RULES

A student visa is required to enter the Russian Federation for all foreign citizens, except nationals of the following countries: Azerbaijan, South Ossetia, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Tajikistan, Ukraine, Georgia, Armenia, Uzbekistan, and Russia.

Holders of diplomatic passports are also exempt from the visa requirement.

All other foreign nationals must obtain a student visa prior to entering Russia.

## How to Obtain a Student Visa for Chechen State University named after A.A. Kadyrov

1

### Admission to the University

Before applying for a Russian student visa, you must first be admitted to Chechen State University named after A.A. Kadyrov (please refer to the university's official website for more information).

2

### Passport Requirements

Ensure that your passport meets the following requirements:

- It must be valid for at least 18 months from your planned date of entry into Russia;
- It must contain at least four blank pages for the visa and entry/exit stamps.
- If your passport does not meet these requirements, you will need to obtain a new one.

3

### Visa Invitation

To apply for an initial single-entry student visa, you must obtain an official invitation issued by the university. This visa allows a single entry into Russia and is valid for 90 days. After arrival, it will be converted into a multiple-entry student visa.

4

### Visa Application Procedure

Visit the official website of the Russian Embassy or Consulate where you plan to apply for your visa and carefully review the list of required documents and application procedures.

You may schedule an appointment in advance; however, please take into account the processing time for the visa invitation, which is at least 30 calendar days.



## 2.11 HEALTH INSURANCE

**Medical Insurance**

A VHI (voluntary medical insurance) policy is a mandatory document for foreign citizens. The absence of a VHI policy is grounds for refusal of entry into the territory of Russia. Every foreign student entering the territory of Russia must purchase a VHI policy for the entire duration of their stay.

When purchasing a VHI policy, you should pay attention to the insurance programme, which should include the following points:

- Medical examination for issue of form O86/y certificate (including fluorography)
- Medical examination to issue a health book for medical personnel
- Blood tests for HIV, Hepatitis B, RW
- Outpatient services, including specialised medical care for acute and chronic diseases
- Urgent and emergency in-patient specialist medical care, emergency hospitalisation
- Medical evacuation/repatriation

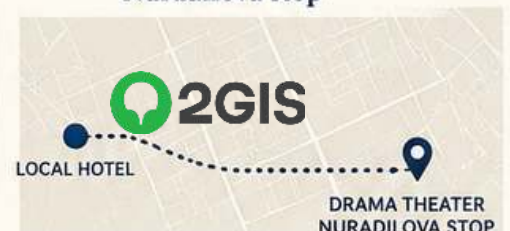

2.12 STUDENT DORMITORY COMPLEX OF  
KADYROV CHECHEN STATE UNIVERSITY

The university takes special pride in the dormitories where all international students are accommodated. Students live in the comfortable two-story cottages for 4–6 people, with a shared living room, a kitchen, and two bathrooms. One room accommodates not more than 2 people. Students have cable internet access. The territory is guarded 24/7, and access is by permit only.

The process of completing the documents for accommodation in the dormitory takes place after arrival in Grozny. The procedure for submitting and accepting documents for dormitory accommodation is outlined in Section 3.0. This information is provided for your familiarization with your future place of residence.

## Campus Life and Recreation

The cottage complex features a sports field located on its territory. This area is actively used for:

- University sports competitions
- Student tournaments and events
- Recreational activities and leisure time

Students can freely spend time outdoors playing volleyball, football (soccer), and participating in various sports and social activities.

The dormitory complex creates a balanced environment that supports academic success, physical activity, and student engagement, making it an ideal place to live and study at ChSU.



## 2.13 STUDENT DORMITORY COMPLEX RULES

## Internal Regulations (Rules of Residence) in the student dormitories of Kadyrov ChSU.

### Pass System:

A pass system is in effect in all Kadyrov ChSU dormitories. The pass is issued by the dormitory manager upon check-in. When entering the dormitory, residents must present their pass in an unfolded form without being reminded. For safety and security of property, the dormitory doors are locked from 11:00 PM to 06:00 AM. To enter the dormitory during this time, a resident must call the watchman (security guard) and present their pass.

### ✔ Residents of the dormitory are obliged to:

- Maintain cleanliness, namely keep their room and common areas clean, and clean up after themselves immediately
- Observe quiet hours from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM, namely: do not make noise, disturb the peace, or create obstacles for the work and rest of residents
- Treat property with care (a fine double the cost of the damaged property will be levied for damage to furniture, appliances, equipment, and premises)
- Observe fire safety rules
- Report violations
- Respect other residents and not create conflict situations

Habitual offenders may be presented by the head of the Student Affairs Management Office to the Rector, Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs, or Faculty Dean for expulsion, dismissal from Kadyrov ChSU, and may also be evicted from the dormitory.

### Habitual offenders include persons:

- Who consume alcoholic beverages
- Who sublet their rooms;
- Who refuse to register at their place of stay
- Who are absent from the dormitory without written notice for more than one month
- Who store explosives, chemically hazardous substances, or firearms in the dormitory
- Who use and distribute narcotic and psychotropic substances
- Who keep living quarters in unsanitary conditions
- Who use provided premises for purposes other than their intended use
- Who occupy spaces and rooms without authorization, preventing the settlement of other residents
- Who systematically violate these Rules

### Visitors:

Visitors are permitted in the student dormitories from 8:00 AM to 9:00 PM. Upon entry, they must present an identity document and register in the visitor log. Residents of the dormitory are responsible for ensuring their visitors depart on time and comply with the Internal Regulations of the Kadyrov ChSU Student Affairs Management Office.

### ✘ Residents of the dormitory are prohibited from:

- Keeping animals in the student dormitories
- Allowing unauthorized persons to stay overnight, transferring their pass to unauthorized persons, leaving parents (relatives) in the rooms (units) where students reside. Accommodation for parents (relatives) is only possible upon written application with permission obtained from the Student Dormitory Management Office
- Strictly prohibited from appearing on the territory of the student campus and in the dormitory in a state of alcohol or drug intoxication, using and selling narcotic and psychotropic substances, bringing into the student dormitory and consuming alcoholic beverages, including beer
- Smoking in living rooms, common areas, and on the territory of the student campus
- Moving inventory without permission

For violation of the internal regulations (rules of residence) in the Kadyrov ChSU student dormitories, the following disciplinary sanctions are applied:

### To students:

- Reprimand
- Severe reprimand
- Expulsion from the university in accordance with the Charter of Kadyrov ChSU with subsequent eviction

### To employees (and other persons):

- Reprimand
- Severe reprimand
- Eviction from the dormitory

For violation of these Rules in the dormitories, upon submission by the Student Affairs Management Office, measures of public or disciplinary action may be applied to residents in accordance with the current legislation of the Russian Federation, the Charter of Kadyrov ChSU, and these rules. The decision to apply a disciplinary penalty in the form of eviction from the dormitory is considered by the leadership of Kadyrov ChSU upon submission by the Student Affairs Management Office in accordance with the Charter of Kadyrov ChSU and the current legislation of the Russian Federation





## 2.14 WEATHER & CLIMATE: WHAT TO PACK (CULTURAL ATTIRE AND NATIONAL ITEMS)

The Chechen Republic has a moderately continental climate with clearly defined seasons: a relatively mild winter and a hot, long summer. The climate varies significantly depending on altitude, ranging from dry lowland plains to cold, snowy highlands.

### Winter ❄️

In the lowland areas, winters are generally mild, with average January temperatures around  $-3$  to  $-4^{\circ}\text{C}$ . However, winter can still feel cold, so it is important to bring warm winter clothing.

### Summer ☀️

Summers are hot and sunny, with average July temperatures of  $+22$  to  $+39^{\circ}\text{C}$ . Rainfall is low, about 300–400 mm per year, so summers are mostly dry.

☂️ It is recommended to bring an umbrella, and 🧴 sunscreen is essential during the summer months.

### Mountain Regions 🏔️

In the mountainous areas, the climate is much colder. Winters are snowy, temperatures are lower, and precipitation is significantly higher—up to 1,200 mm per year. Glaciers remain in the high mountains throughout the year, creating a striking natural landscape.

Overall, Chechnya offers a diverse climate, allowing visitors and students to experience everything from warm summers in the plains to alpine conditions in the mountains.

### **Cultural Attire and National Items**

As you prepare for your arrival, we kindly encourage you to bring your national or traditional clothing and other cultural items. Throughout the academic year, the university hosts various cultural, educational, and international events where students are invited to present and celebrate their cultural heritage.

Your traditional attire and cultural symbols will give you the opportunity to share your identity, traditions, and history with the university community, promote intercultural dialogue, and take part in vibrant cultural exchanges. These events are an important part of student life and help create a diverse, respectful, and inclusive environment on campus.

We look forward to learning about your culture and celebrating the richness of our international community together.



**Q1. Can I buy medical insurance in my own country?**

A: Foreign companies offer travel insurance, which does not cover planned treatment in Russian medical centers. To receive quality and timely medical care while studying in Russia you need to buy a medical insurance policy from a Russian company. It includes a minimum list of necessary medical services, and is accepted in clinics and hospitals - you can choose the one closest to the place where you will live or study. With health insurance you will not have to pay for standard medical services, you will just have to prove that you have a policy and a student ID card or passport.

**Q2. Do I necessarily have to buy a health insurance policy for the time I study in Russia?**

A: According to the Russian law, since 2016, it is necessary for every foreign citizen to have a medical policy. Since May 1, 2016 the minimum insurance amount for foreign citizens has increased to 500 000 rubles (**The amount may change. Please confirm the current amount with the University's International Office.**), it should be taken into account when applying for a medical insurance policy. Students can buy the policy on their own in the insurance company or arrange it with the help of international university department specialists. Absolutely all international students must purchase a medical policy at their own expense. On average, a medical insurance policy costs from 6,000 to 9,000 rubles per year.

**Q3. Can I get Russian citizenship after graduating from a Russian university?**

A: A foreign graduate of a Russian university may obtain Russian citizenship and even do so in a simplified procedure, if several conditions are met: he/she must have received education in the main educational programs that have state accreditation, in a state university on the territory of Russia. In addition, he/she must have worked in Russia in his profession for at least one year before applying. This will have to be confirmed when applying for citizenship - to submit a work certificate or a copy thereof, certified by the employer in the prescribed manner, as well as to provide other necessary documents.

**Q4. Can I stay in Russia after graduating from a Russian university and to work?**

A: It is not so easy to do. While studying at a Russian university a foreign student is in the country on a student visa, it is issued for the period of study. After graduation, you cannot stay in Russia and get a job without a work visa or a work permit. However, you can work while you are studying at the university.

**Q5. How much money does a student spend on average in Russia? How much money do I need for the first time?**

A: On average, a student needs \$300-400 per month to live in Russia. But at first it is better to have about \$300-400 more for additional expenses - medical insurance, arrangement of an apartment or dormitory (purchase of dishes, bedding, detergents). Of course, this is an approximate amount - it all depends on your habits and needs. You can spend both more and less. In general, Russian university students have a lot of benefits, which allows them to save money on transportation, entertainment and more. In addition, most universities have their own sports complexes, where students can practice for free or for a small fee.

**Q6. How do I enroll as a fee-paying student?**

A: For the current admission process you will not be able to apply for fee-based studies through education-in-russia.com. To do this, contact the university of your choice personally and find out what you need to do to enroll in a university for a fee.

## 3.4 SIM CARDS &amp; MOBILE OPERATORS

In accordance with Federal Law No. 303-FZ of August 8, 2024, "On Amendments to the Federal Law 'On Communications' and Certain Legislative Acts of the Russian Federation," new SIM card registration rules for international students are coming into effect.

· Starting from July 1, 2025, SIM cards of foreign citizens that have not been re-registered through biometric data will be deactivated.

You must re-register your SIM card according to the new rules:

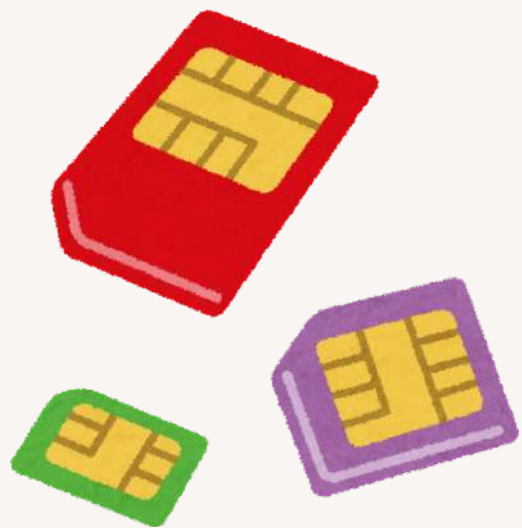
- Obtain a Social security number (SNILS) at a multifunctional center, the Social Fund of Russia, or through your employer – you will need your passport and a notarized translation of it.
- Register in the Federal State Information System "Unified Portal of State and Municipal Services" – your account can be verified at a bank branch or at the office of multifunctional center.
- Submit your biometric data at a bank branch.
- At a mobile service provider's office, re-register your existing SIM card or order a new one. Enter into a contract and activate the SIM card via a biometric terminal or in the Federal State Information System "Unified Portal of State and Municipal Services".

To open access to "Gosuslugi" (the Unified Portal of State and Municipal Services) and obtain an SNILS, please refer to the following sections in this chapter: 3.9. "Gosuslugi" – Unified Services Portal of Russia 76 page.

## 3.5 Registration at the place of residence on the territory of the Chechen republic



1.

Primary registration (migration registration) is the mandatory process of registering a foreign national at their place of stay within 7–90 days (depending on citizenship) after entering the Russian Federation; it is usually valid for 90 days. The cost of primary registration is 500 rubles.

Secondary registration is an extension of the primary registration based on an employment contract, a residence permit (VNZh/RVP), or studies. The cost of secondary registration is 1,000 rubles. Extension of legal stay in the Russian Federation after the expiration of the primary registration period.

2.

Once you are accommodated at the University dormitory you have to come to the International Office at Main Campus, 32 Sheripova St. and submit your passport, visa and migration card.

3.

International Office applies for your registration at the Migration Office.



5.

Pick up your registration at the International Office 3-5 working days after your documents have been submitted.

4.

We recommend you open Sberbank card and pay the state fee for registration through the Sberbank mobile application: 500 rubles for primary registration or 1,000 rubles for secondary registration.

6.

### Travelling in Russia

If you travel within Russia and stay in another city for more than 7 working days, you will need to receive a new registration. The hotel/hostel or a private home you will stay at will have to register you at their address. After you return to Grozny, you must apply for a new registration again.

7.

### VISA EXTENSION

A visa obtained in the relevant country (single-entry) is valid for 90 days.

❖ To apply for a multiple-entry visa for 1 year, you must submit the following documents to the International Cooperation Office at least 45 days before the visa expiration date:

- Original passport;
- Original migration card;
- Original detachable part of the notification of arrival.

❖ The state fee for issuing a multiple-entry visa can be paid at any bank, **but the amount may change. Please confirm the current amount with the University's International Office.**



## 3.6 CERTIFICATES OF MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Starting from December 29, 2021, foreign citizens must undergo the procedures of medical certification and fingerprinting and photographing. You must do this within 90 days of your entry into the Russian Federation.

Medical certification is a yearly procedure. Foreign citizens must undergo repeated medical certification within 30 days of the expiration date of the previous medical documents.

Mandatory fingerprinting and photographing is done once and free of charge.

### 3.7 CERTIFICATE OF DACTYLOSCOPIC EXAMINATION (GREEN CARD).

**Fingerprint** is one form of biometrics, a science that uses people's characteristics to identify them.

Foreign citizens who arrived in the Russian Federation for a period exceeding 90 calendar days are required to undergo mandatory state fingerprint registration, photographing and medical examination. This is stated in paragraphs 13 and 18 of Article 5 of Federal Law No. 115-FZ of July 25, 2002 On the Legal Status of Foreign Citizens in the Russian Federation."

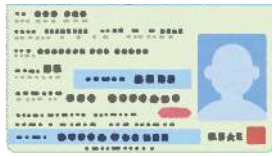

### 3.8 RVPO: TEMPORARY RESIDENCE PERMIT FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES (RVPO)

#### How to Apply and What It Offers

From January 1, 2023, international students and postgraduate students in Russia can obtain a Temporary Residence Permit for Educational Purposes (TRPE).

This permit is issued to full-time students enrolled in degree programs for the entire period of study, plus an additional 180 calendar days after graduation. This extra time allows graduates to apply for a Permanent Residence Permit after completing their studies.










#### Benefits of the Temporary Residence Permit for Educational Purposes (RVPO)

- Eligibility for social support, including free medical care
- No requirement to submit annual notifications confirming residence and income
- The right to apply for a Permanent Residence Permit within three years after graduation without obtaining a standard temporary residence permit
- No requirement to prove proficiency in the Russian language, knowledge of Russian history, or the basics of Russian law
- If the international student enters Russia under a visa regime, a visa valid for the entire TRPE period will be issued
- Simplified employment process after graduation, with no need to obtain a work permit

### 3.9 HOW TO REGISTER ON THE 'GOSUSLUGI' WEBSITE AS A FOREIGNER

#### What is 'Gosuslugi'?

'Gosuslugi' is Russia's official government services portal designed to facilitate electronic interactions with state authorities. It enables users to quickly fill out digital documents, monitor fines, and submit applications directly to corresponding departments online, substantially reducing procedural times. Foreign citizens residing or intending to live in Russia can fully use this platform, even without possessing a Russian passport.

#### WHY SHOULD A FOREIGNER REGISTER ON 'GOSUSLUGI'?

##### 1 SIM Card Acquisition

Required for purchasing and legally registering a local cellular network SIM card within Russia.

##### 2 Business Operations

The most efficient method to submit required documentation and open a local business (e.g., a café or beauty salon).

##### 3 Driver's Licenses

Crucial for processing, applying, or obtaining an official Russian driver's license.

##### 4 Place of Stay Registration

Enables direct, remote submission of mandatory notifications regarding your place of physical stay or residence in Russia.

##### 5 Work Permits & Patents

Provides streamlined administrative procedures to apply for and manage a legal work permit or labor patent.

##### 6 Stay Extensions & Settlement

Mandatory tool used to extend temporary stays or complete legal permanent residency and settlement workflows.

#### IDENTITY VERIFICATION & ACCESS PROTOCOL

##### ✓ Full System Access and Identity Verification

Initial profile registration is fully flexible and can be initiated **without a Russian passport or phone number**. However, to attain unhindered full access to the portal's complete spectrum of state features, you must verify your identity offline. To complete this procedure, you will need a personal **'SNILS' number** (Insurance Number of an Individual Ledger Account).

##### ⚠ Limitations for Unverified Accounts:

While using the portal without confirming your identity is permitted, the scope of accessible state services remains strictly restricted. Unverified accounts are limited exclusively to a small set of basic functions: booking medical

In your personal account, enter your passport details and your 'SNILS' number. You can get a 'SNILS' at any 'Moi Dokumenty' ('My Documents') office across Russia ([more info](#)). You'll need your passport and a notarized Russian translation.

### Verification of your account

Finally, verify your identity:  
 – In person at a service center ([locations](#)).  
 – Online via a Russian bank (if you have an account there). Check your bank's website for confirmation (e.g., [Sberbank](#) or [T-Bank](#)).

### How can a foreigner obtain a 'SNILS' number?

'SNILS' is a unique number in the pension insurance system assigned to every insured individual in Russia. Before 2019, it was issued as a small green card with a number, but now, it is provided in an electronic format.

Foreigners may also need it – not only those coming to work or study but, in some cases, even tourists.

You can apply for a 'SNILS' number at the nearest office of the Social Fund of Russia ([official website](#)) or at an MFC ('My Documents' center), with branches available in all Russian cities. If you are employed in Russia, your employer can also arrange it for you.

7.

### Required documents for SNILS:

Passport and its notarized Russian translation  
 – Document confirming legal stay in Russia (temporary residence permit, residence permit, visa, etc.)

– Completed ADV-1 form (download [here](#))  
 The form must be filled out in capital letters without corrections. You can complete it at home or at an SFR/MFC branch office.

A 'SNILS' number is usually issued within five business days.

Important notes:

– A 'SNILS' number is issued once in a lifetime and does not change even if you switch citizenship or last name.  
 – If lost, you can restore the number at any MFC branch.

- Pay Button (Оплатить): The yellow button at the bottom displays the final amount and confirms the payment.

**Q1. Where do CHESU students apply for RVPO?**

A: If a student decides to stay in the Russian Federation for more than one year, it is recommended to apply for an RVPO.

To apply, the student must collect all documents listed in Section 3.7 and submit them to the International Office of the University at the following address:

32 Sheripova Street

**Q2. How much does RVPO cost?**

A: When you apply for RVPO you have to pay the standard state fee for the service - it's 3100 rubles. Only cash!

**Q3. What should I do if my visa is about to expire and I still haven't got my RVPO?**

A: You may stay legally in Russia even in such situation with expired visa based on the document, issued to you in Directorate for Migration Affairs Ministry of Internal Affairs for the Chechen Republic, on the acceptance of your application for RVPO. Most important is to extend your registration based on the same paper before the current registration expires at the address of your stay. After/ if you get RVPO, you'll need to update registration again and keep on staying in Russia according to the duration dates of your RVPO

**Q4. What should I do after I get RVPO?**

A: Then you may consider applying for permanent permit (BHЖ) after you get your diploma of graduation + RVPO. Study the information of permanent permit in advance on the website of mc.mos.ru It's also issued through Migration Affairs Ministry of Internal Affairs for the Chechen Republic

**Q6. Who must register a foreign citizen?**

A: Landlords (owners of places of residence) must register foreign citizens at their actual place of residence.

**Q7. If I lose my green card (dactyloscopic certificate), can I restore it?**

A: No, the green card cannot be restored. We strongly advise you not to lose your documents and to keep them all in one folder for safety.

### DESTINATION: "ENGLISH CASTLE,"

The Grozny Oil Research Institute Building, popularly known as the "English Castle," was built in 1928 in the Gothic style from red brick. It was commissioned by the local representative office of a British oil company.

Originally, the building housed engineering offices and laboratory facilities for conducting chemical research. Its pointed arches, vaulted ceilings, large windows, and a small tower on the roof create the appearance of a medieval European structure. Due to its distinctive architecture and historical connection with Britain (often poetically referred to as "Foggy Albion"), local residents began calling it the "English Castle."

During the Soviet period, the building was home to the Grozny Oil Scientific Research Institute. Today, the historic structure operates as a restaurant.

The National Library of the Chechen Republic named after Abuzar Aydamirov is one of the oldest libraries in the North Caucasus. It was founded in 1904.

Khoi Settlement is an ancient city of watchmen.

Khoi is one of the oldest Chechen settlements, located in the Vedensky District of the Chechen Republic. It stands at an altitude of 1,826 meters above sea level. Its name comes from the Chechen word "Kho," which means "guard," "watch," or "settlement of watchmen."

Until the 12th–13th centuries AD, the lowland territories of the North Caucasus were inhabited by various peoples who formed a unique union of North Caucasian tribes. The location chosen for the settlement of Khoi was likely determined by the highlanders' desire to protect their families, taking advantage of the mountainous landscape and the solid natural foundations suitable for building homes and fortresses.

Today, the highland settlement of Khoi is protected by the state as an architectural monument. Since 2017, it has effectively become an open-air museum.

The entrance fee is 200 rubles.

In the mountain village of Kharkaroy, a staircase leading to a cave with a natural spring has recently been opened. The staircase is 306 meters long and consists of 1,000 steps leading to this natural landmark.

The staircase is equipped with solar-powered lighting and observation platforms, allowing visitors to enjoy panoramic views of the surrounding mountains.

From the cave, visitors can see the Kharkaroy Battle Tower, the only surviving medieval structure in the village of Kharkaroy. The tower rises four stories high and stands on a rock. Its walls reach a height of 16 meters, making it an impressive historical monument of the region.

The Ushkaloy Towers are two restored watchtowers located in the Argun Gorge. They were built in the 10th–11th centuries along the Transcaucasian trade route, serving as defensive and observation structures that controlled and protected the strategic passage through the gorge.

Scientists suggest that in the past the watchtowers were used as a customs post: travelers had to pay a toll to cross the bridge over the river. In the 20th century, the towers were destroyed, but they were later restored.

Why go: To see several waterfalls in one place.

Destination: The National Library, Castle, Avenue Esambayev

**DESTINATION: "ENGLISH CASTLE,"** MORNING ( 11.00 - 12.00 )

The Grozny Oil Research Institute Building, popularly known as the "English Castle," was built in 1928 in the Gothic style from red brick. It was commissioned by the local representative office of a British oil company. Originally, the building housed engineering offices and laboratory facilities for conducting chemical research. Its pointed arches, vaulted ceilings, large windows, and a small tower on the roof create the appearance of a medieval European structure. Due to its distinctive architecture and historical connection with Britain (often poetically referred to as "Foggy Albion"), local residents began calling it the "English Castle."

During the Soviet period, the building was home to the Grozny Oil Scientific Research Institute. Today, the historic structure operates as a restaurant.



**DESTINATION: THE NATIONAL LIBRARY** AFTERNOON ( 13.00 - 15.00 )

The National Library of the Chechen Republic named after Abuzor Aydamirov is one of the oldest libraries in the North Caucasus. It was founded in 1904. Visitors to the National Library of Chechnya have access to five reading halls and electronic resources connected to the largest libraries in Russia. The library serves more than 12,000 readers annually.



**DESTINATION: MAHMUD ESAMBAYEV AVENUE** AFTERNOON ( 15.30 - 17.00 )

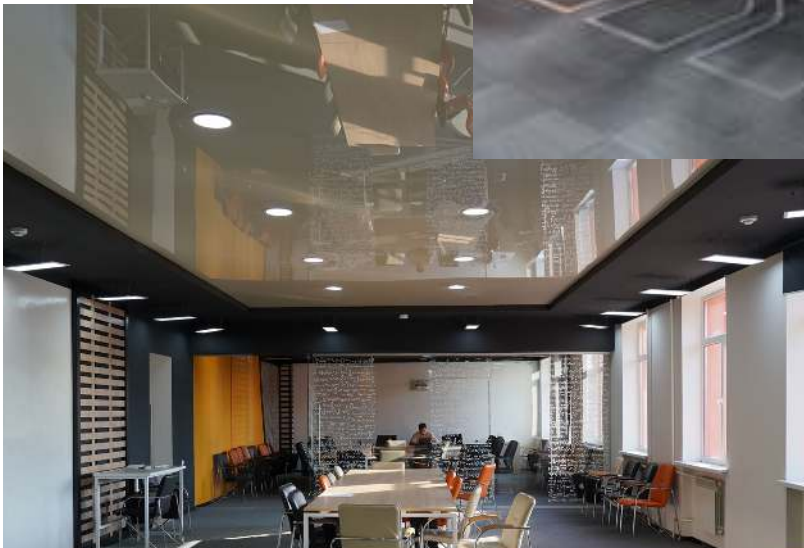
Mahmud Esambayev Avenue is a modern pedestrian boulevard in Grozny, in honor of the outstanding Chechen dancer and People's Artist of the USSR, M. Esambayev. 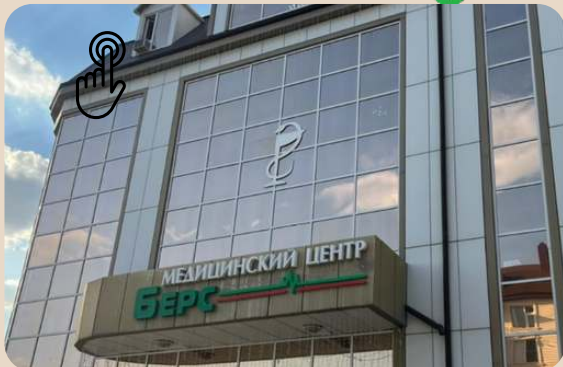

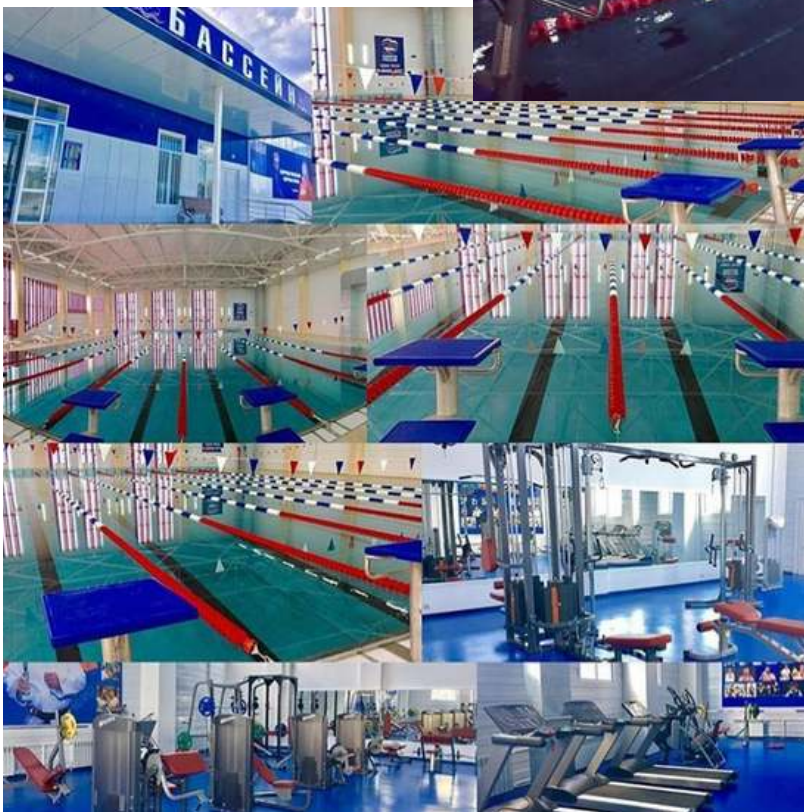

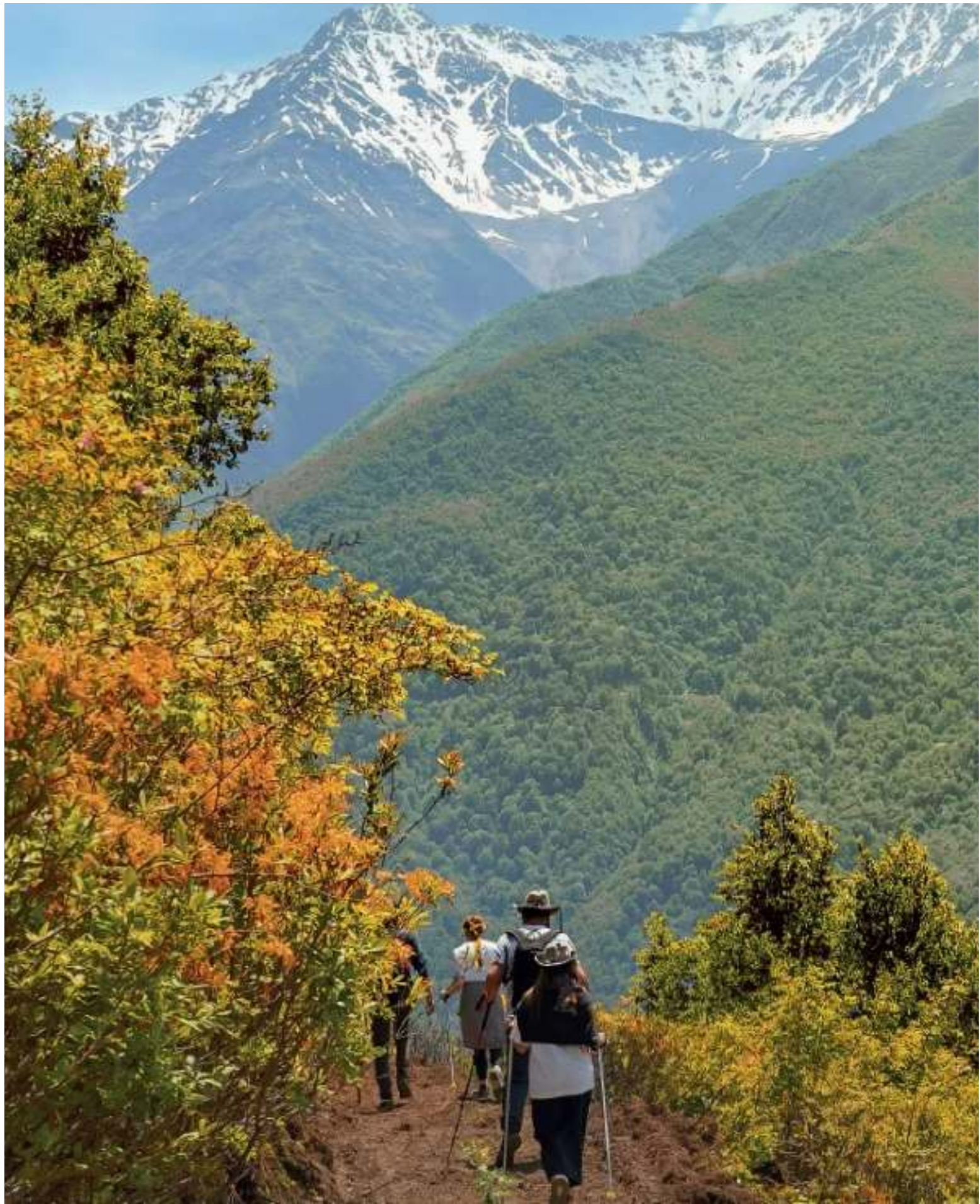

## 4.13 SPORTS FACILITIES &amp; GYMS

If you are interested in eco-trails or hiking, then you should definitely visit the Veduchi All-Season Resort. It is located in the Itum-Kalinsky district of Chechnya. Summer is the best time to explore Veduchi, with more than 30 kilometers of eco-trails available. The trails are well-equipped with gazebos, panoramic viewpoints, and clear signs—everything you need for a comfortable and enjoyable hike.



At the Veduchi All-Season Resort, one of the popular routes is the “Stone Meadow” trail (**На каменную поляну**).

The hike takes about 2 hours, with a total distance of 2.5 km. Even on hot days, the area remains pleasantly cool, making it a comfortable and refreshing walk.

It is strongly recommended to contact the resort in advance and go hiking with an instructor, as wild animals can be found in the mountains.

At the Veduchi All-Season Resort, there are several scenic hiking routes to explore:

- Health Trail (**Тропа здоровья**): takes about 2 hours to complete, with a distance of 2.5 km.
- Omichu Trail (**Омичу**): a longer route of 7 km, with an approximate hiking time of 3 hours.

**National Library of the Chechen Republic named after Abuzar Aidamirov**

The National Library of the Chechen Republic named after Abuzar Aidamirov is the first public library in Grozny. Founded in 1904, it has become one of the most important cultural and educational centers in the region, providing access to knowledge, research resources, and information for students, scholars, and the general public.

The library offers a wide range of free services, including:

- Access to electronic catalogs
- Assistance in preparing bibliographic lists
- Virtual reference services
- Online book renewal
- Reference and bibliographic support
- Access to remote digital resources
- Access to the electronic library
- Internet access and free Wi-Fi
- Access to information about the library's collections through catalog systems and other information services

**English Castle (Grozny Oil Research Institute Building), the historic building of the Grozny Oil Scientific Research Institute.**

The building was constructed in the 1920s and commissioned by the British oil company Shell, which had a large representative office in Grozny at that time.

The structure is built in the Romanesque architectural style with Gothic elements, giving it the appearance of a medieval castle. Because of this distinctive architecture, the building became popularly known as the “English Castle.”

Originally, the building served as the central laboratory of Grozneft, the major oil company operating in the region. In 1928, the research institute moved into the building. During that period, the oil industry was rapidly developing, and the science of oil refining was also experiencing significant growth. As a result, the building was dedicated to scientists and researchers working in the field of petroleum technology.

Today, the “English Castle” remains an important historical and architectural landmark, symbolizing the scientific and industrial heritage of Grozny.





## 4.14 PLACES TO VISIT IN GROZNY

**At the Grozny Sea Complex, you can visit the spectacular “singing fountain.”**

The fountain is designed in the shape of a traditional Chechen national ornament. It is 300 meters long and 34 meters wide, making it one of the largest fountains in Russia. Water jets rise up to 100 meters high, creating an impressive visual effect. Modern technologies allow the fountain to produce two large water screens used for projections and shows. Numerous projectors create stunning light and color effects, while special fire elements add even more excitement – flame jets can reach up to 60 meters high, creating a dramatic contrast with the water.

The fountain operates in the evenings from the 1st of May and during the summer season every day



The Flower Park is a true gem of modern urban landscape design, located in the very heart of Grozny. This magnificent park covers an area of 4.5 hectares, situated next to the famous Grozny City high-rise complex and not far from the impressive “Heart of the Mother” mosque.

The park is renowned for its elegant landscaping and an extraordinary number of floral arrangements. Around 150,000 flowers are planted here, decorating 467 specially designed metal structures that create bright and memorable art installations.



## 4.14 PLACES TO VISIT IN GROZNY

At the “Grozny Mall” shopping and entertainment center, you can visit the “Kinostar” cinema chain, which features the first premium-class Sphera cinema hall in Russia.

The mall offers 7 modern screening halls with a total capacity of 933 seats, including the Sphera hall and a VIP hall.

Sphera is a premium-class cinema experience. There are only three such cinemas in the world—in Paris, Athens, and Jeddah—and now the fourth one is located in Grozny.

The Sphera hall is equipped with a cutting-edge 50-channel Dolby Atmos Premium surround sound system with the MAG THOR subwoofer, one of the most advanced cinema subwoofers in the world. It also features an interactive 360° dynamic lighting system, creating a fully immersive movie experience.



The Flower Park is a true gem of modern urban landscape design, located in the very heart of Grozny. This magnificent park covers an area of 4.5 hectares, situated next to the famous Grozny City high-rise complex and not far from the impressive “Heart of the Mother” mosque.

## 4.14 PLACES TO VISIT IN GROZNY

Esambayev Boulevard is one of the central streets of Grozny. It stretches from Central Square to Theatre Square, where the Chechen State Drama Theatre named after Khanpasha Nuradilov is located. Along the boulevard, you'll find benches, flower beds, leisure areas, and beautiful lighting that create a welcoming atmosphere. The street is also home to shops, pharmacies, and a nearby park. There are many cafés and restaurants here, including Crispy, Drinks, Coffee Story, Tbilisi, and Nutella. Esambayev Boulevard is also a place where local creativity comes to life. Artists display and sell their paintings, and music lovers sometimes play the piano, adding a special charm to a casual walk.



The concept of the boulevard changes with each season: in winter, the area is decorated with glowing garlands; in autumn, umbrellas hang above the street; and during the holy month of Ramadan, lights shaped like crescents and stars create a festive atmosphere. The boulevard is almost never empty—you might only catch it quiet when the decorations are being changed.



On Esambayev Boulevard, there is the Youth Theater, where a young girl organizes screenings of some of the most famous films in cinema history.

If you would like to attend a screening, you should follow her on social media and watch for announcements about upcoming films at the theater. Ticket prices are affordable, usually up to 400 rubles.

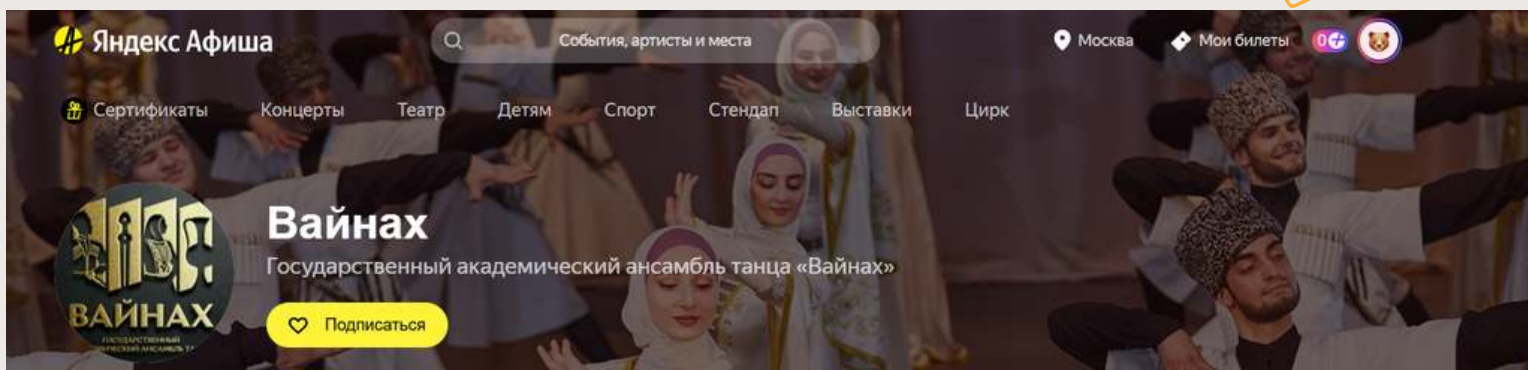

In 1975, the ensemble received its first order – the “Star of Jordan,” the highest state award, presented by King Hussein bin Talal following a triumphant performance in Jordan. At that time, “Vainakh” was the only ensemble in the USSR to receive this highest distinction.

## 4.15 CULTURAL LIFE



### “SHASHLIK-MASHLIK” FESTIVAL ONE OF THE MOST DELICIOUS FESTIVALS IN GROZNY

The “Shashlik-Mashlik” gastronomic festival is one of the most vibrant and flavorful events in the Chechen Republic, attracting tourists from all over Russia.

This international festival of tourism, gastronomy, and active recreation takes place annually in Grozny, bringing together cultures, cuisines, and traditions from different regions.

The festival program includes:

- regional tourism exhibition
- Caucasian fair
- culinary competitions featuring chefs from across Russia
- concert program with national music
- workshops and contests
- free tastings of meat dishes

Thanks to the festival, the Chechen Republic has become a popular destination for tourists and food lovers. One of the recent festivals welcomed around 47,000 visitors in a single day, coming from across the region and the country.

## What is Shashlik?

Shashlik is a traditional dish popular in the Caucasus and many Eastern countries. It typically consists of marinated pieces of meat (such as lamb, beef, or chicken) grilled on skewers over an open flame.

It is known for its rich flavor, smoky aroma, and the social experience of cooking and sharing food together – making it an important part of cultural hospitality.

## Are there vegetarian options?

Yes! Although the “Shashlik-Mashlik” festival focuses on meat cuisine, it also offers a variety of vegetarian dishes.

Visitors can enjoy:

- grilled vegetables (eggplant, peppers, tomatoes)
- traditional flatbreads
- cheeses and dairy products
- fresh salads
- legume-based dishes
- sweets and desserts

This makes the festival enjoyable for both meat lovers and vegetarians.

## HONK-FEST: WILD GARLIC GASTRONOMIC FESTIVAL

The Wild Garlic Gastronomic Festival HONK-FEST took place in 2026 in the central square of Vedeno and was dedicated to the Year of Mountain Regions and the Development of Small and Medium-Sized Businesses.

The festival program includes tastings of traditional national dishes, competitions, a folk crafts fair, masterclasses from leading chefs, and live musical performances.

The highlight of the festival is the traditional competition “Dika Zuda”, where participants compete in fast wild garlic cleaning.

But most importantly – unlimited wild garlic for everyone!

The festival is held annually in February and is dedicated to wild garlic, a traditional dish in Chechen cuisine. It is especially appealing for vegetarians, as many dishes are plant-based.

Visitors have the opportunity to try a wide variety of food and traditional dishes – all free of charge.

The festival takes place in different locations across the Chechen Republic.

“VkusDoma” hypermarket is located about 15 minutes from the dormitories by bus №29. It is one of the largest hypermarkets in the Chechen Republic.

Prices here are not as low as in local supermarkets, but it is convenient for monthly shopping trips. “VkusDoma” is a modern retail complex with an area of around 10,000 square meters, combining a shopping hall, a food court, and rental spaces.

Inside the hypermarket there is a meat and fish section, as well as a café area called Coffee Store. It is a comfortable place for large, planned grocery shopping once a month.



### LOCAL MARKET “Berkat”



“Berkat” is the largest market in the Chechen Republic. There you can find fresh meat, groceries, fruits, vegetables, clothing, shoe repair services, key copying, and pharmacies.

The market is organized into different blocks, making it easier to navigate. To find the required section, you can use the 2GIS app for orientation and directions.



Fresh meat is available in the Meat Pavilion, Block 52.

Along Block 52, you will also find fruits, vegetables, and sour cream.

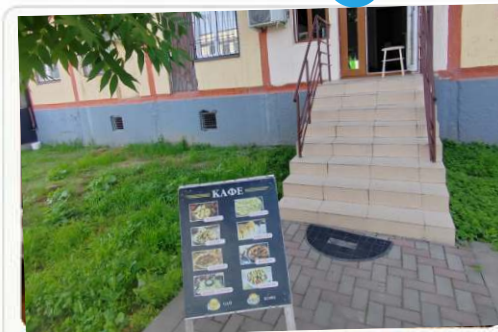

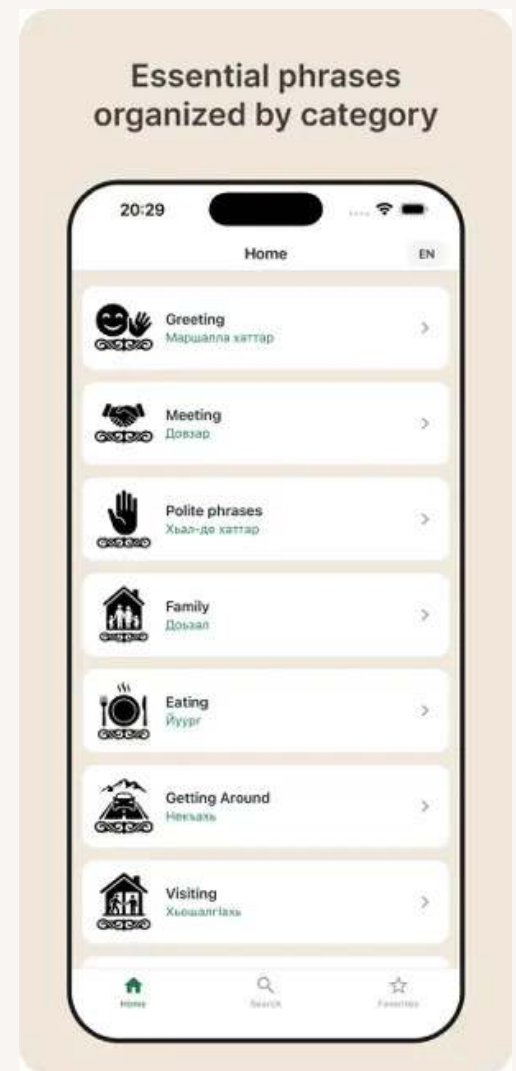

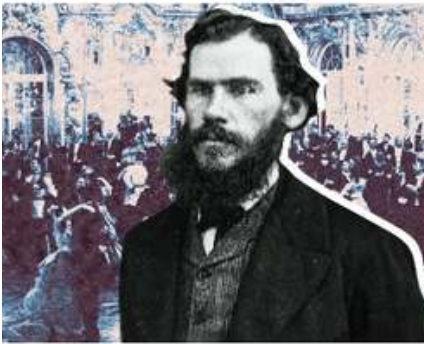
